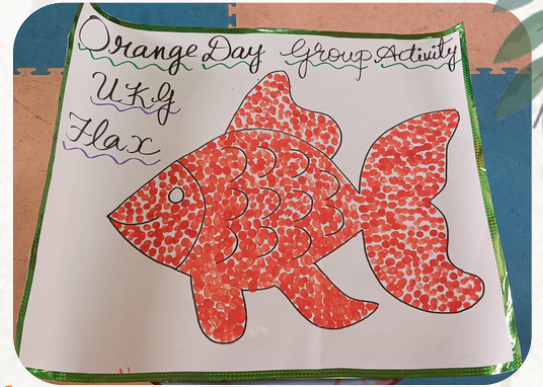
May the months and years that await us provide us life-learning experiences and life-long joys.

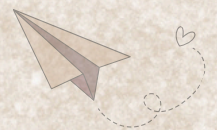


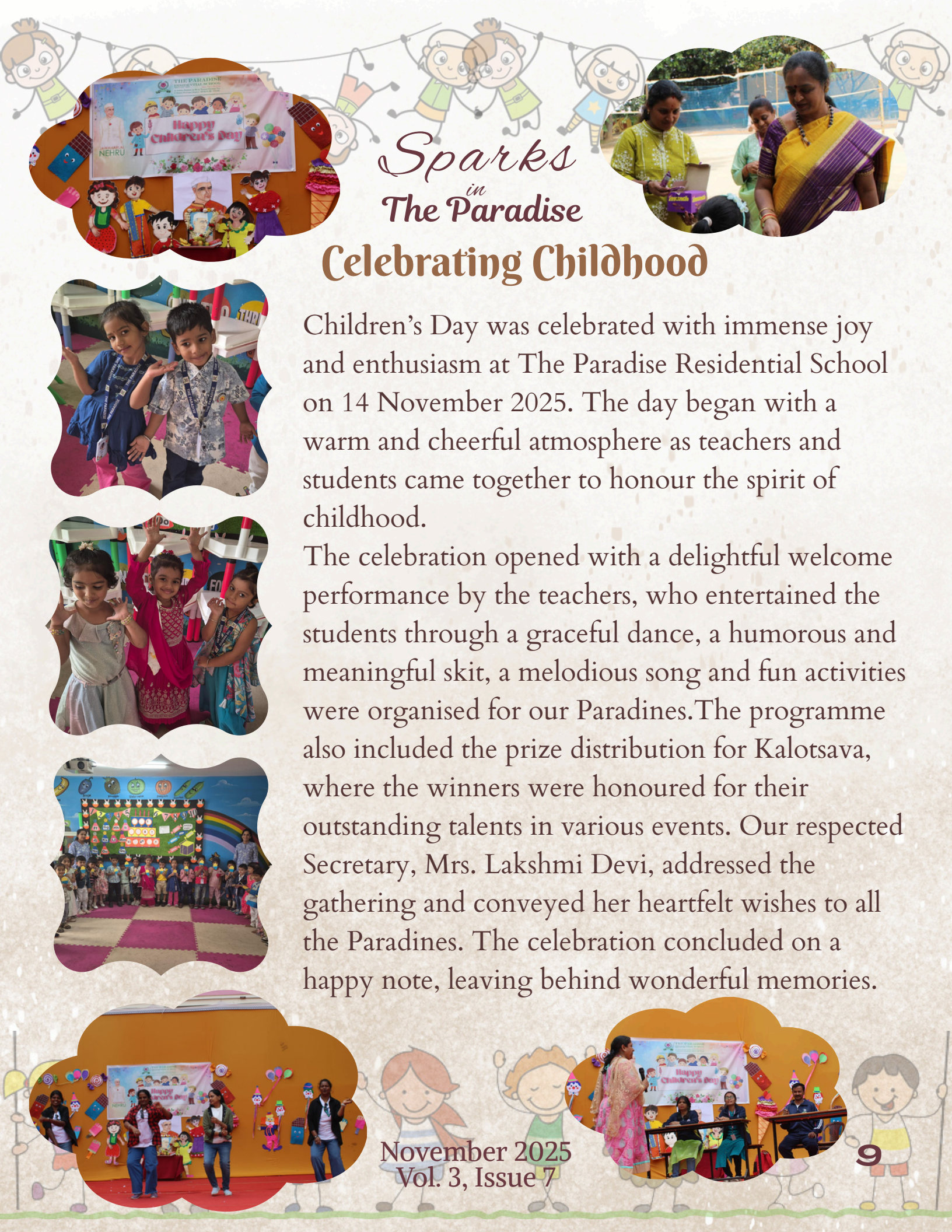
ORIGAMI in Hands

Rise and Shine Assembly

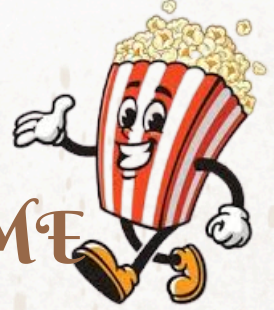

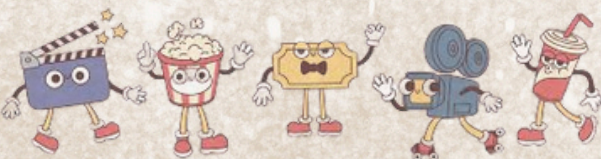


MOVIE TIME
